Privacy Policy

Sparks & Favor, P.C. ("Sparks & Favor") respects your privacy and is committed to protecting it through our compliance with this policy. The information we collect automatically is statistical data. It helps us to improve our Website and to deliver a better and more personalized service. We may disclose aggregated information about our users to reputable third parties, but these statistics will not include any personally identifying or medical information.

Children

We understand the need to protect children's privacy online (we define "children" as minors younger than 13). We do not knowingly collect or use any personal information from children. We do not knowingly allow children to register with us, communicate with us, or to use any of our online services.
